

**Minutes of Old Florida Heritage Highway Corridor Management Council–  
June 23 , 2010, Herlong Mansion Long Hall Meeting Room, Micanopy, FL**

Meeting was called to order at 2:30pm. All present introduced themselves.

[Andi Christman mentioned the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Florida State Parks will be observed at the Prairie with a “Walk thru Time” and David Carr recommends inviting Ney Landrum]

Planning for Micanopy July 4<sup>th</sup> events- Text for cell phone tour will be finalized by Les Singleton and provided to Miriam Deckert to finalize card. Debrah Miller will arrange for FDOT printing. Kathleen will distribute the cards at the Parade event.

Byway support organization development

Articles and Bylaws documents were reviewed.

Articles of Incorporation were considered and a Motion made by Les Singleton and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott Richardson to accept the articles subject to the technical revisions.

Ed Geers requested to add to the motion to include the Micanopy Pearl as the physical address and mailing address. The incorporators are Scott Richardson, Ed Geers and David Carr. Scott Krueger will be listed as registered agent. Approved unanimously.

Bylaws were discussed and various comments were expressed. Ed recommended a subcommittee to review the bylaws. Scott, Ed and David or Ashley Wood [who was not present].

Motion by Les S. with 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lucinda R. to proceed with subcommittee review of the Bylaws. Approved unanimously.

Computer Applications

A proposal was presented by FDOT consultant Mike Palozzi to include a tour of 20 stops along the Corridor, with creation of Apps for GPS and/or I Pod technology, at an estimated cost of \$7,000-\$12,000. Discussion followed, noting there are now 3 technology platforms. David Carr demonstrated the Blue Ridge App example.

Debrah Miller suggested the Central Scenic Byway office should submit application for a state app project.

Other –Valerie Rivers mentioned that County Public Works is working on resurfacing plan for CR 325 and noted community concerns. Todd and Scott recommended Community Involvement, and Valerie mentioned Judy Harris and Kate Barnes are holding a meeting June 29. Kathleen Pagan will review Cross Creek Special Area Plan and discuss with Public Works.

[Staff Note: The County Commission decision was to design 2 foot shoulder along CR 325].
